



<b>Key vocabulary:</b> <p><b>Britannia</b>– Roman Britain.</p> <p><b>centurion</b> – An officer in the Roman army who commanded an army of around 100 legionaries.</p> <p><b>consul</b> - One of two men who held the highest position in the senate of the Roman Republic.</p> <p><b>empire</b> - A group of countries ruled by a single person, government or country.</p> <p><b>hierarchy</b> - A system where people or things are arranged in order of importance.</p> <p><b>invasion</b> – Act of entering a place to take control.</p> <p><b>legionary</b> – A soldier in a Roman army.</p> <p><b>Roman citizen</b> - A person who had privileges and protection from the Roman state.</p> <p><b>Romanise</b> – To become Roman.</p>			<b>Timeline:</b> <div data-bbox="1153 603 1516 663"> <p>Roman Britain</p> </div> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>55-54BC – First and second invasion of Britain by Caesar</li> <li>AD43 – Claudius invades and conquers Britain.</li> <li>AD60-61 – Boudica rebels against Roman rule.</li> <li>AD122 – Hadrian's wall is built.</li> <li>AD211 – Londinium becomes the capital of Roman Britain.</li> <li>AD313 – Christianity becomes legal in the Roman Empire.</li> <li>AD400 – Roman army gradually leave Britannia</li> <li>AD410 – Roman rule ends.</li> </ul> <div data-bbox="1534 549 2192 930">  </div> <p>Roman Empire, AD 117–200</p> <div data-bbox="1662 995 2181 1377">  </div>
