**Aliens love underpants by Claire Freedman and Ben Cort**

**Monday**

Listen / watch the story 'Aliens love underpants'

Discuss the story. Talk about what happened at the beginning, middle and end

**1. Talk about the story. Answer some of the following questions:**

How many aliens can you spot?

Why do you think they like underpants?

What are the aliens traveling in?

What type of underpants do they like best?

**2. Dance like an alien** – how do you think an alien would dance?

**3. Design your own alien.** Think about what they might look like. What sounds do they make? Are they friendly? Can you write 2 sentences to describe your alien? (see template)

**4. Design a pair of pants for your alien.** What colours will you use? Will you use a pattern?

**5. Use playdough to make an alien.**

**6. Design a rocket / spaceship for your playdough alien.** Use things from your recycling bin to create a model.

**7. Make stick puppets to go with your rocket.** Use these to help retell the story or to make your own story (see template)

8. **Design your own planet for the aliens to live on.** What shape and colours might it be? What might your planet be called? Write a sentence to describe your planet.
9. **Can you help your adult hang the washing on the line and count how many items you can fit on it.**
10. **Maths – cut out and order the alien and spaceship picture by size** (see template)
11. **Science - wax crayon underpants painting** (see template)
12. **Create a world for aliens using an old shoe box.**



13. **Story sequencing** - colour in and cut out the pictures. Can you put them in the correct order and retell the story to a family member (see template)
14. **10 things I would like to take in my rocket on my adventure to space** - can you think of 10 things you would like to take to space with you (see template)
15. **Make a book review-** write about the main characters, the setting and what happens in the story (see template)
