Over the summer, we would like your child to revisit the four number operations: addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.







Mastery: Reasoning and Problem-Solving


In September, there will be a spelling test based on the Year 2 common exception words. These are the spellings that children should know by the end of Year 2. You will find these in the back of the reading diaries.
