




Y2 Curriculum Planning Document – Week 4




5 children want to buy sweets from the shop. They want to share them equally. Which bag should they buy? Explain why.




Noah had these strawberries to share with his 10 friends. Molly had the same number of strawberries to share with her 5 friends.


