Previously, CHPA ran our own wraparound provision through CHOOSE. However, after looking into various options of how we move this forward, in order to provide children who need it with fully engaging, enjoyable and wide-ranging activities, CHOOSE will no longer provide this provision. Instead, we will be working with a specialist wrap around provision company called JPAC. JPAC are a well-established and very experienced in providing breakfast & end of day provision and will also be providing the option for holiday club provision (something that we were unable to provide before), which from the feedback of the questionnaire, was something that many parents would find helpful.
