## Weekly Newsletter Update – WEEK 3

Dear Parent/Carer,

Welcome to Newsletter 39 – the last Newsletter of the academic year.

I want to start with a huge thank you to each and every one of you for the support you have given to CHPA over what has been the most difficult year that education has faced since WW2. The uncertainty each day has brought, with the spectre of Covid, the possibility of bubble closures and the impact this has had on CHPA events, pupils, staff and yourselves.

Up until late June, when Sheffield, like the rest of the country had a huge surge in positive cases, we have been limited in the closures we have had to manage. However, in the last few weeks, the bubble closures have had significant impact on nearly all year groups, which has resulted in a number of pupils missing the usual end of years, with this having the biggest effect on the Y6's who have not experienced their usual rite of passage from leaving primary and moving on to their secondary journey.
